




Do you feel things in the country are going in the right direction, or do you feel things have gotten off on the wrong track?






How would you rate the job Barack Obama has been doing as President? Do you approve or disapprove of the job he is doing?






How would you rate the job Barack Obama has been doing as President? Do you approve or disapprove of the job he is doing?






What do think is the <u>most</u> important issue for President Trump and Congress to focus on in the first 100 days of his term?


Thinking about the recent election for President of the United States Which candidate did you vote for?






Which of the following emotions <u>best</u> describes how you feel about the election results?



Which of these statements best reflects your view on the sometimes coarse language used in this Presidential campaign:




