




### Do you feel things in the country are going in the right direction, or do you feel things have gotten off on the wrong track?






### How would you rate the job Joe Biden has been doing as President? Do you approve or disapprove of the job he is doing?


### How would you rate the job the Democrats / Republicans in Congress have been doing? Do you approve or disapprove of the job they are doing?




### **COVID-19 Vaccine Mandates**

Do you favor or oppose states and the federal governments requiring their employees and their contractors to receive the COVID-19 vaccine?


Do you favor or oppose private businesses requiring their employees to receive the COVID-19 vaccine?






Thinking for a moment about the issue of student loans... Some political leaders have suggested that the federal government should end debt for most student loan borrowers.

Would you say you favor or oppose the U.S. government ending the remaining student loan debt for most student loan borrowers?




### And, thinking one last time about the national economy... Do you believe that the next generation will be: Better off, Worse off, OR About the same as the current generation?




### And, thinking about the issue of political civility for a moment -




### Thinking about the issue of political civility for a moment

Do you have any friends who have political views that are very different than your own?




### Do you have any family members with whom you are no longer able to talk because of their views about politics and current events?
