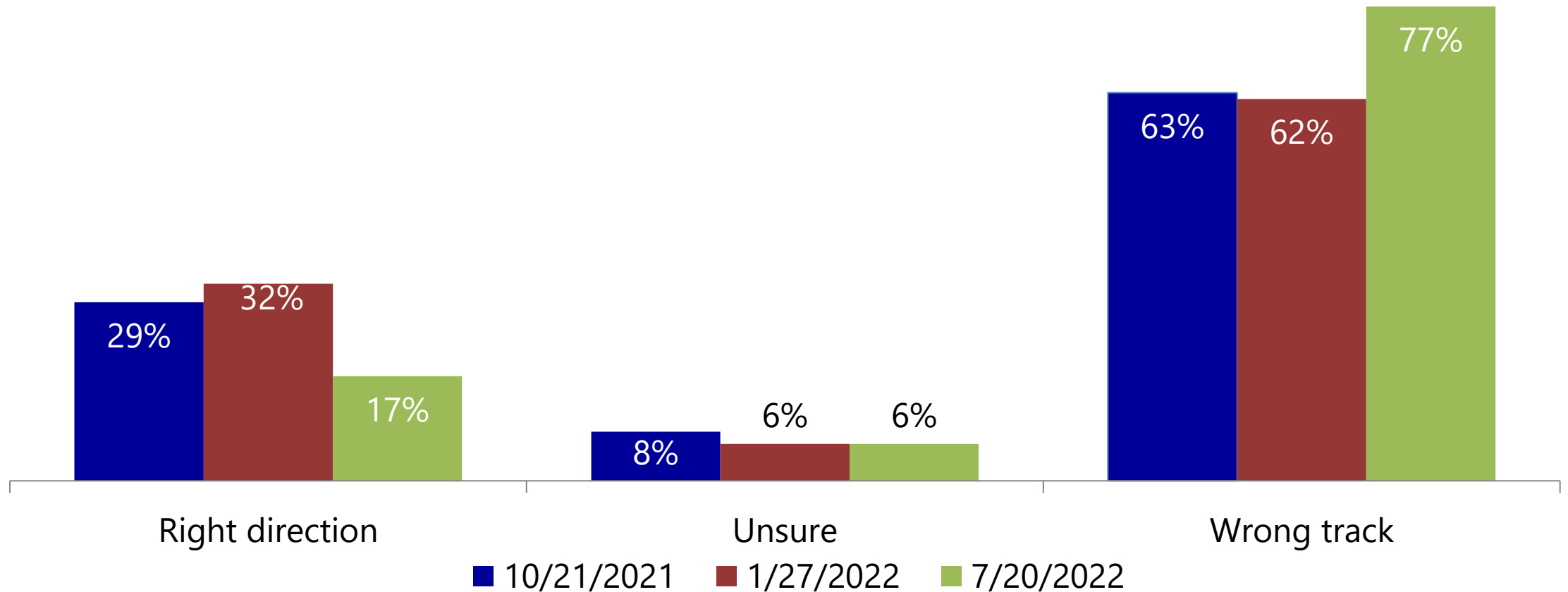

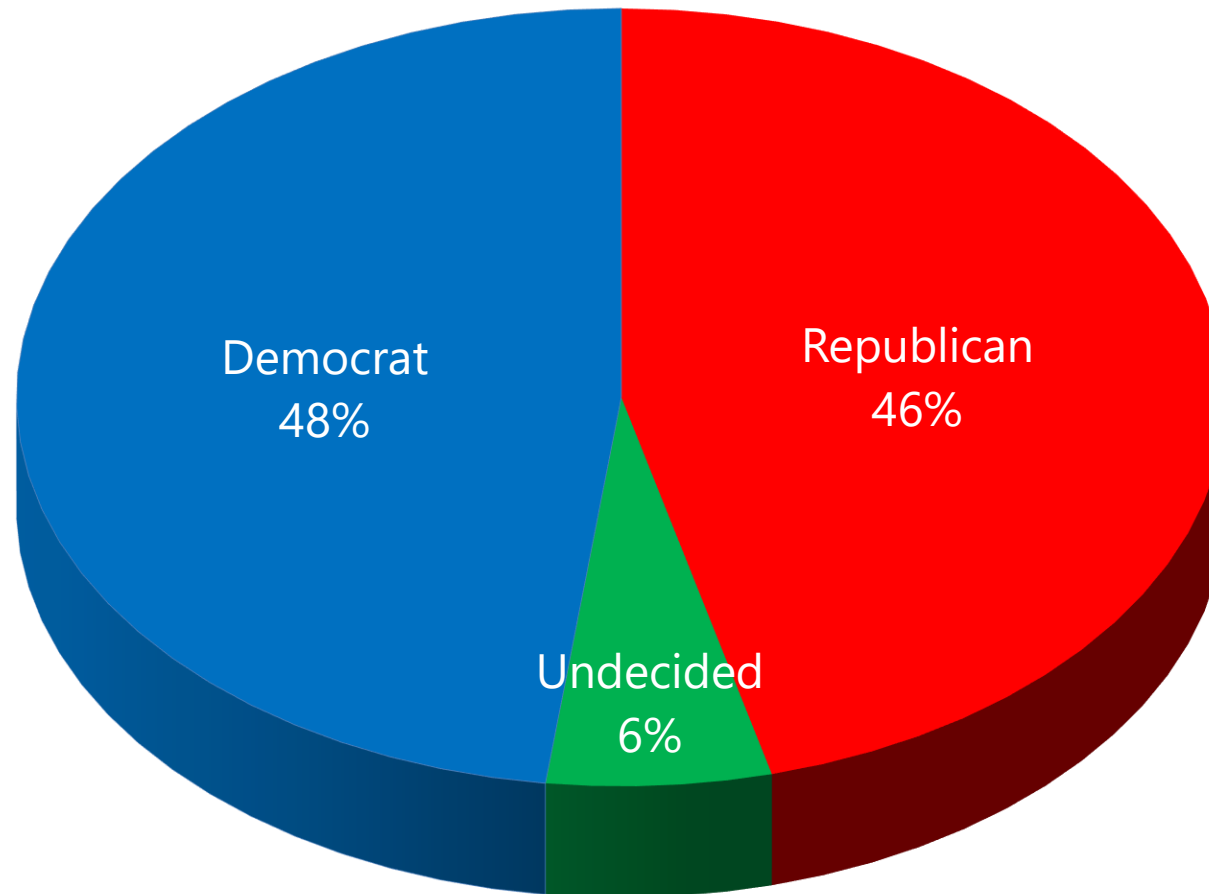

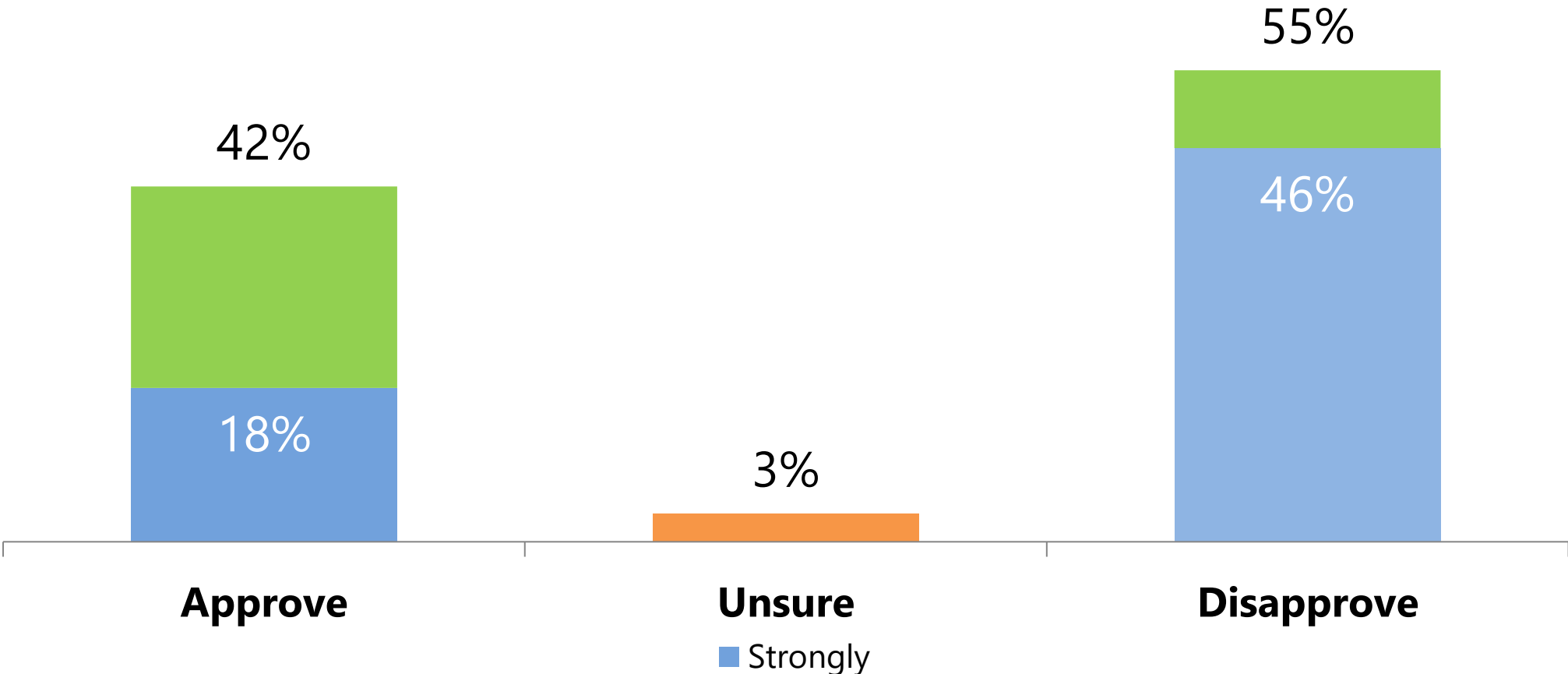
# Do you feel things in the country are going in the right direction, or do you feel things have gotten off on the wrong track?



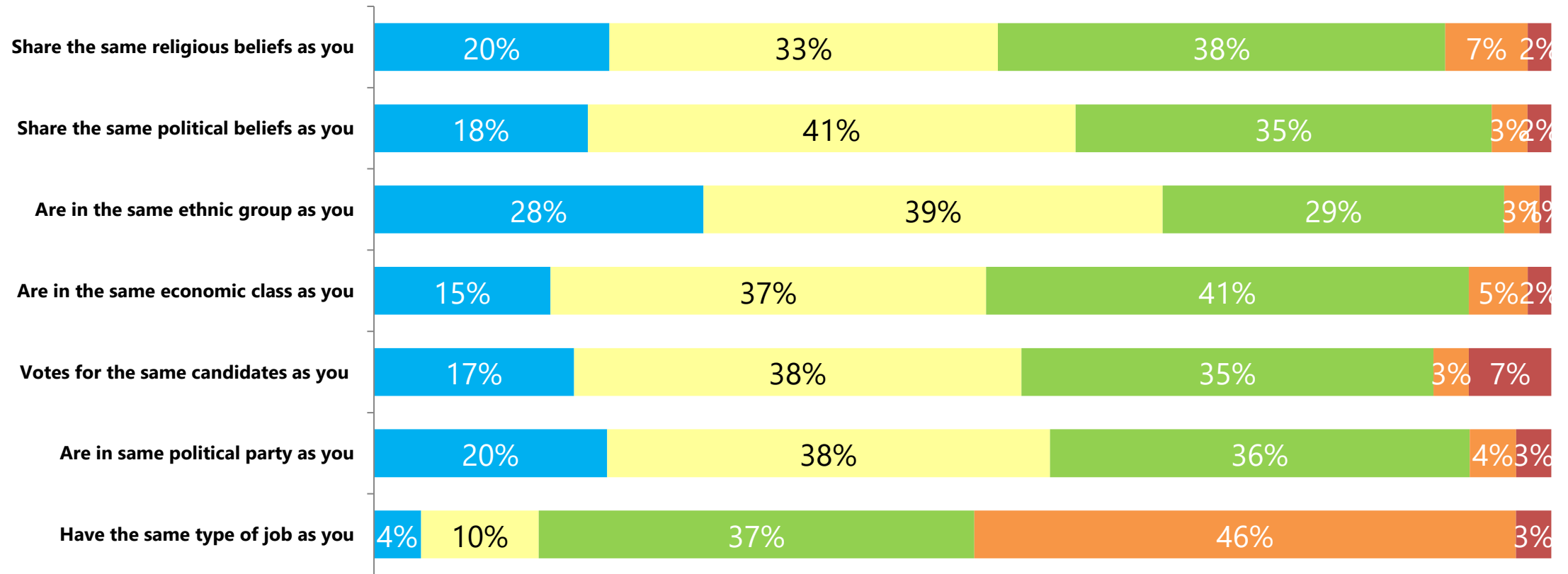
**If the election for Congress were being held today, and you had to make a choice, would you be voting for...  
the Republican candidate, OR the Democrat candidate?**



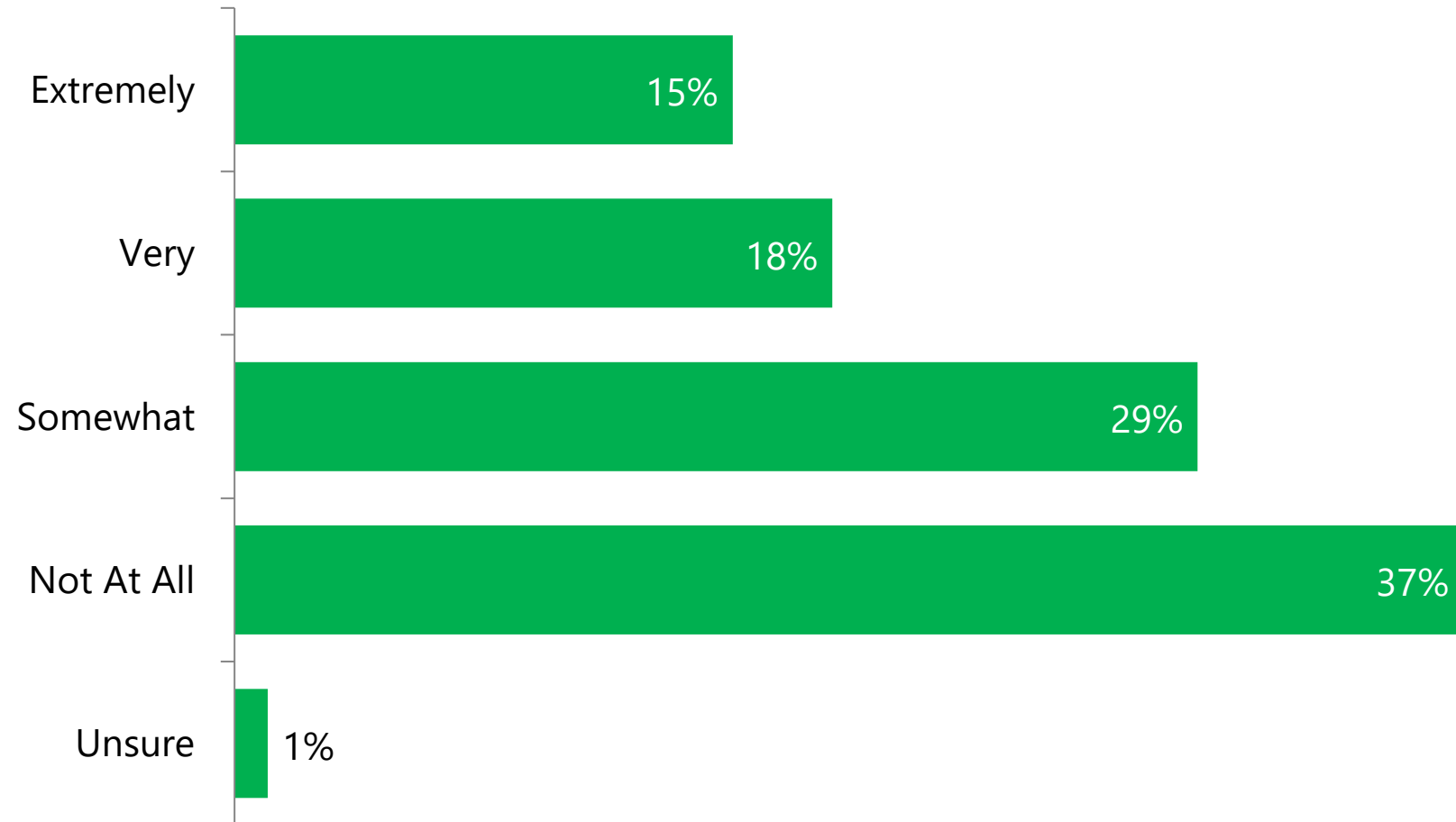
# Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as President?



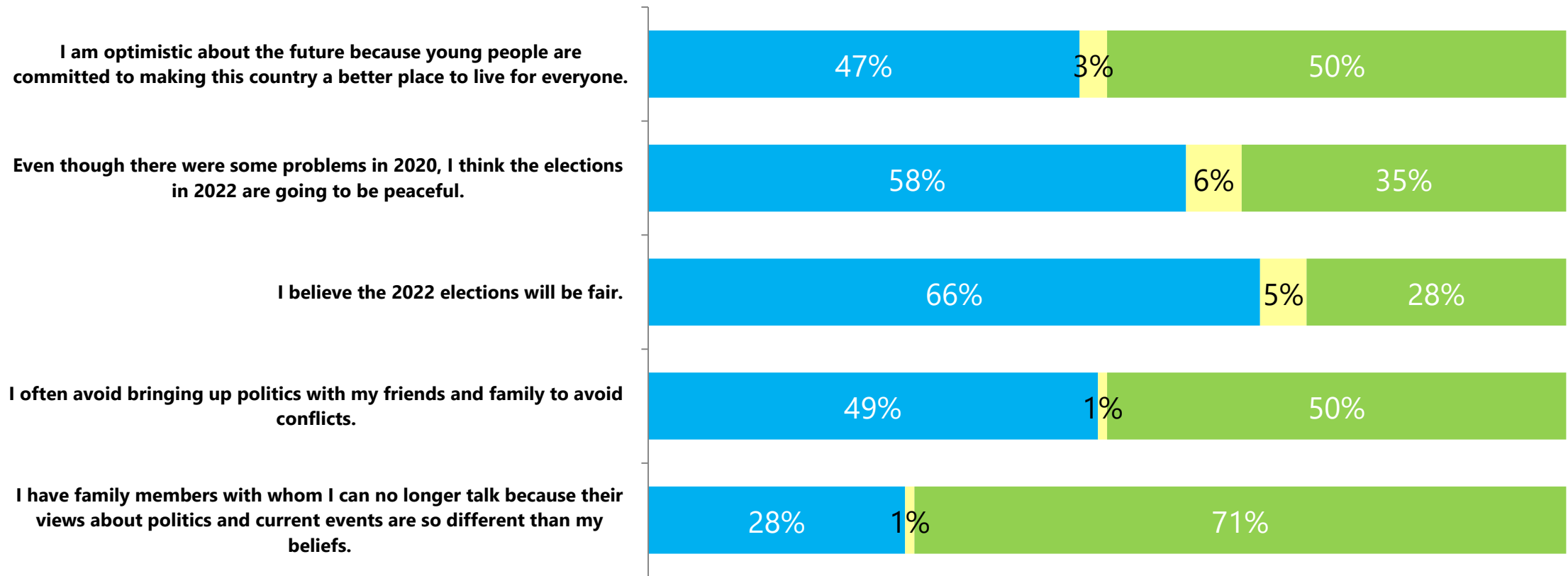
**Now, I want you to think about your close friends and family. I am going to read you a list. For each item, please tell me if all, most, some or none of your close friends and family share this item.**

**Now, I would like to read you a list of statements. Please listen carefully as I read each statement and tell me if you would agree or disagree with that particular statement.**

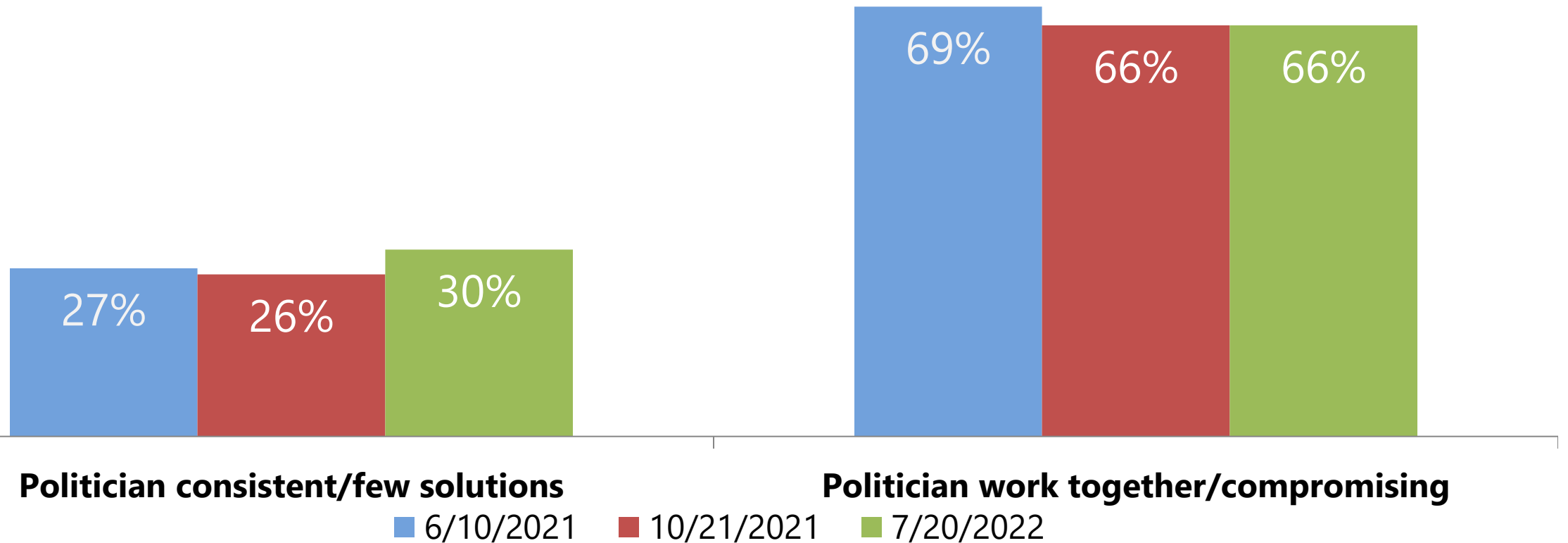

## No matter what you think about political civility, which of these would you prefer:

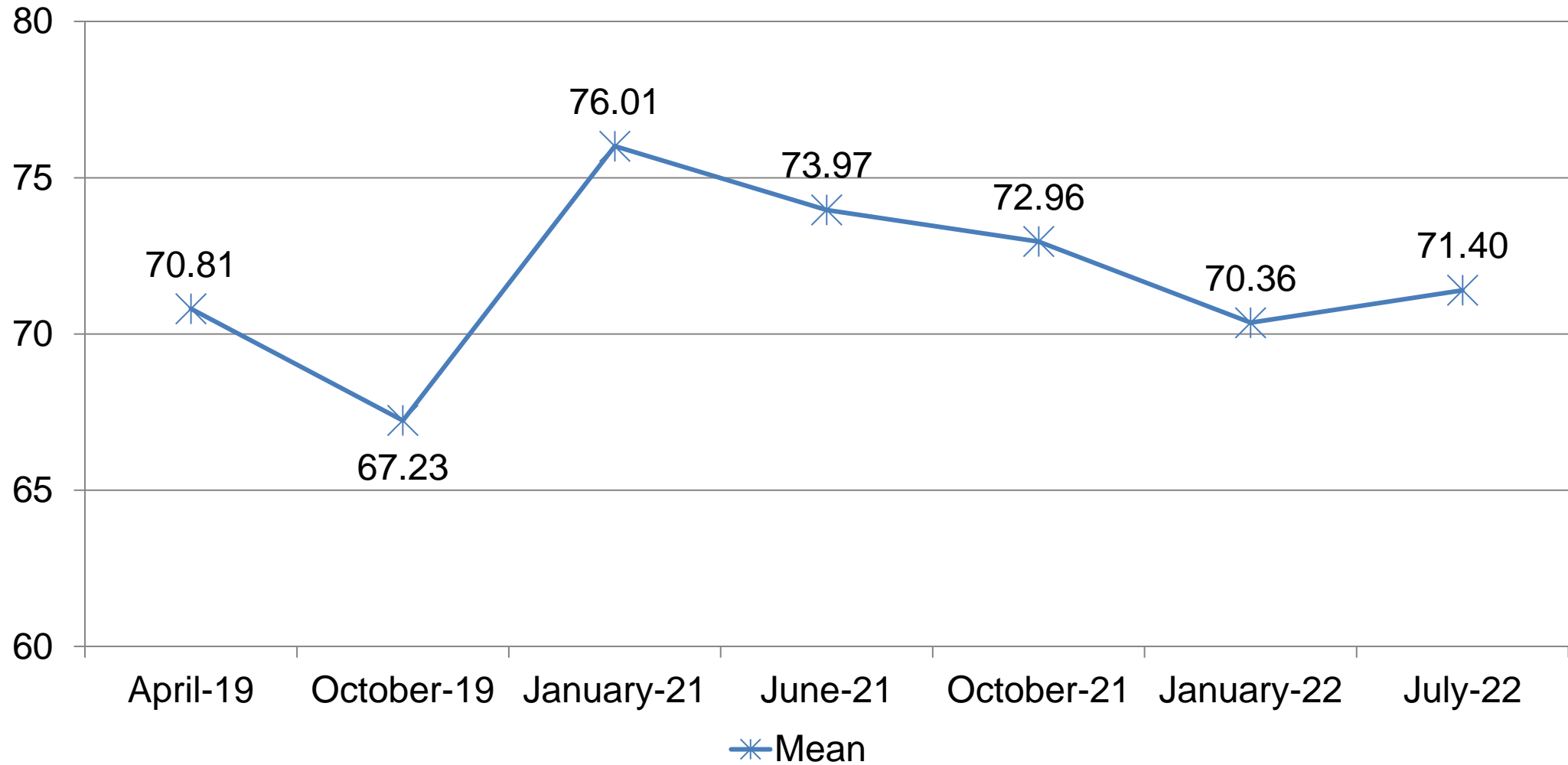
A politician who consistently fights for my values, even if this means not finding a solution very often,
